The student and chaperone will accompany cooperative delegates on visits with U.S. Senators and Representatives from New York State.

This is an excellent learning experience for students. He or she will gain first-hand experience in how our government works. They will also have the opportunity to visit many of the interesting and historic sites in our nation's capital with other student representatives from New York State rural electric cooperatives.
